

Geneva Township
Regular Meeting
February 8, 2017

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Mills at 7:30pm.

Those present were Mr. Brown, Mr. Mills, Mr. Russell, Fiscal Officer Long and Zoning Inspector Cerjan,

Minutes from the January 2017 meeting were approved, on a Motion by Mr. Russell and a Second by Mr. Brown.

Bills in the amount of \$46,096.28 covered by e-payments E-5 – E-16 and Warrants 19006 - 19051 were approved, on a motion by Mr. Russell and a second by Mr. Brown, All trustees voted yes.

Fire Department Report:

Chief Arkenburg reported that unit 321 had some problems. Three have been resolved at this time. The Ladder Truck also has some issues which are being addressed. Lightning caused multiple problems at City Hall. There must have been multiple strikes. The new reporting Software is up and running. The Training Station Internet problems have been resolved. The training center will be inspected; however there is still some work to be done. We had a public records request for the intersection of Maple and Route 534. At this point, Mr. Russell has provided all of the documentation that we have.

Road Department Report:

Jim Burhenne reported that they have been plowing and chasing high water areas. They have completed repairs to several Trucks. A water problem was reported on Austin road which was resolved once a Deer was removed from the drainage ditch. He presented quotes from three vendors for snow fences. These would be wooden fences to control drifting. We need to determine where these fences would be needed since we would have to obtain permission from property owners. Trustees approved getting 300 – 400 feet of fence to test their use and effectiveness. A total of \$900.00 is authorized for this project at this time. There was a request that the ditches along Lake Road to Padanarum be cleaned. It was agreed they would be cleaned in the spring when weather permitted. This would be the south side of the road. Ditched would be cleaned and dead trees removed.

Zoning Department Report:

Mr. Cerjan reported that a complaint was received about 4148 Lake Road East with junk and rubbish in the yard. The property at 4278 Lake Road is being cleaned up. He issued a permit at 3780 Myers Road for an addition. He received a complaint about the landlord of rental property. It is the responsibility of the Landlord in this case. He received a complaint about young kids living in a camper at 4838 East Maple Ave. He investigated and found no one living there. He reported that a pond had been put in at 4380 Jamison Lane. They will be getting a permit for an addition to the house. Other complaints investigated were standing water in a yard on Lake Road East, he found no standing water. Ditch on Spencer drive needs to be cleaned, it will be done in the spring.

Mr. Long reported that he will be attending HIPAA training and Certification on February 22, 2017 in Cleveland.

Mr. Russell reported that NAD has had 77 calls already this year. This is up from previous years. One reason is that Community Care has been overloaded and NAD has been taking some of those calls.

Mr. Brown reported on the 534 Corridor meeting. He questioned about the bike path route through the Township. Until the City determines the route through the City, it does not appear the Township can determine the route through the Township.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 8:20 pm on a motion by Mr. Russell and a second by Mr. Brown. All trustees voted yes
