

Geneva Township
Regular Meeting
February 10, 2021

Chairman Mills called the meeting to order at 7:30pm.

Those present were Mr. Mills, Mr. Russell, Mr. Brown and Fiscal Officer Mrs. Huff, Zoning inspector Ron Cerjan

Absent: Road Supervisor Tod Young

Mr. Russell made the motion and a second by Mr. Mills approved minutes from the January regular meeting. Both Trustees voted yes.

Mr. Russell made the motion and a second by Mr. Brown to approve bills for \$71,919.47 covered by e-payments E1-E-24 and Warrants 21421-21458.

Fire Department: Mr. Russell reported that they purchased a metal cabinet to put on the bridge on Maple Avenue over Wheeler Creek, in order to store hard suction for the fire department.

Zoning Report: Mr. Cerjan stated that the property owner on West Maple Avenue has been contacted and the tenant is being evicted and the owner is starting the clean up on the property. Kirsten Coleman is requesting to combine several parcels into three parcels. Mr. Cerjan will be contacting the county building department.

Road Department: Mr. Russell reported that Brian Henry was taking the Mack truck to R&R trucking in Akron for software updates.

Fiscal Officer Report: Mr. Huff presented Resolution 2021-02 to authorizing to accept the 2021 NOPEC Community Grant. A motion was made by Mr. Russell and a second by Mr. Brown. All Trustees voted aye. A discussion will be made at later date regarding what the revenue will be spent on. Mrs. Huff stated that two levies are up in 2021. The road levy will probably be on the November ballot as renewal and the Fire Levy will go on in the spring. We will start the process for an informal request to see what each levy would generate.

New Business: Mr. Russell stated that he contacted T. Martin for an estimate to pave Spencer Drive and Spencer Circle, instead of Chip and Seal. An E-mail was received from the Ashtabula County Prosecutor officer and would like to meet with the trustees. A special meeting will be scheduled in the future.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned at 7:50pm, motioned by Mr. Russell and second by Mr. Mills. All trustees voted yes.
