

Geneva Township
Regular Meeting
March 8, 2017

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Mills at 7:30pm.

Those present were Mr. Brown, Mr. Mills, Mr. Russell, Fiscal Officer Long and Zoning Inspector Cerjan,

Minutes from the February 2017 meeting were approved, on a Motion by Mr. Russell and a Second by Mr. Brown.

Bills in the amount of \$55,790.58 covered by e-payments E-18 – E-30 and Warrants 19043 - 19117 were approved, on a motion by Mr. Russell and a second by Mr. Brown, All trustees voted yes.

Fire Department Report:

Chief Arkenburg reported they have been dealing with fallen trees in the last couple of weeks. Two large trees on South and North Broadway created some problem. He is waiting to hear on a number of Grant requests, hopefully he will next week. He will be attending the Annual Arson Investigation class. He commented on the recently passed legislation covering Firefighters with Cancer. Part of it is a prevention program. He reported that there were over 80,000 without power after the most recent storm which resulted in over 7000 emergency calls.

Road Department Report:

Jim Burhenne reported they have been looking for a source for grindings. We have an estimated 100 tons of Road Salt left on our contract. We will be ordering the remainder soon. A portion of Padanarum road was closed due to a fallen tree north of Maple Avenue. The City has their portion of North Avenue closed.

Mr. Russell made the motion and Mr. Brown the second to purchase various stone as follows:

- # 304 and #411 from Arms Trucking
- # 8 & #9 from Simak Trucking
- # 57 from Benson Trucking

Zoning Department Report:

Mr. Cerjan reported a permit was issued for a sign at the old American Alert building on Route 20 East. A retail store will be using the property at 4858 NRE. He will check to see that the sign is erected per our Zoning Code. He received a request from CIR to erect a modular structure which does not meet our Zoning Code. He received a report that the property at 4148 LRE was burning garbage, after investigation he found no evidence of burning garbage. He did request the property owner to clean up the property. He has also fielded a number of inquiries about Zoning in the Township.

Mr. Long reported that he will be attending the Local Government Conference in Columbus on April 12 & 13. He also will be making a presentation at the Conference. We have received our first half settlement from the County. Due to a reduction of the Waste Management property, our settlement was reduced by over \$53,000.00.

Mr. Russell made the motion and Mr. Brown the second to sponsor the following:

Recreation Department Summer Movie at \$300.00
County Township Association Meeting at \$250.00

All Trustees voted yes.
