Regular Meeting
April 14, 2021

Chairman Mills called the meeting to order at 7:35pm.

Those present were Mr. Mills, Mr. Russell, Mr. Brown and Fiscal Officer Mrs. Huff, Zoning inspector Ron Cerjan

Mr. Russell made the motion and a second by Mr. Brown approved minutes from the March regular meeting. All Trustees voted yes.

Public Comments: Mr. Douglas inquired if Ms. O'Toole responded from the last meeting. Mr. Russell responded he signed up on the county web site but will check with her tomorrow.

Fire Department: Mr. Russell reported that Dale Arkenburg will be retiring in 2021, no date has been set.

Zoning Report: Mr. Cerjan stated three permits were issued in March. He hasn't met with Lynn Fortier regarding the Fortier Parcel on Austin Road. Dollar General store moving along, but waiting for the county regarding permits. Will need sign permit in the future. Mr. Russell mentioned a new construction sign on Route 20 west and was inquiring if a sign permit was issued. Ron stated he will look into it. Mr. Cerjan also stated that he will contact the Health Department regarding the tire on Maple Avenue. It was suggested that they could utilize the Township Cleanup day on May 1.

Road Department: A resolution 2021-04 was presented regarding authoring participation in the ODOT Road Salt Contracts awarded in 2021. Per Mr. Russell, they talked with Tod Young and it was suggested 700 tons needs to be ordered. Mr. Russell made the motion and a second by Mr. Brown. Roll Call and all said aye.

Mr. Mills stated that ditches in the township looked good and the employees are doing a good job. An inquiry regarding the truck Chassis, and have no idea when that will be received.

Fiscal Officer Report: Mrs. Huff stated that we received the 1st Half settlement in March.

Committees: Mr. Mills set in a zoom meeting with Harpersfield and Geneva on the Lake regarding the walking trails, along with Holly Maranik, head of Metro Parks. The trail will go down Austin Road. Looking at different funding options.
