

Geneva Township
Regular Meeting
May 9, 2018

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Mills at 7:30pm.

Those present were Mr. Brown, Mr. Russell, Mr. Mills, Fiscal Officer Long and Zoning Ins. Cerjan.

Mr. Russell made the motion and a Second by Mr. Brown approved minutes from the April regular meeting.

Mr. Russell made the motion and a second by Mr. Brown, All trustees voted yes to, approve bills for \$ 71,610.61 covered by e-payments E-48-60 and Warrants 19805-19851.

Fire Department Report:

Fire Chief Arkenburg reported that the new Truck is being prepared for service. There have several trees down as well as power lines from the recent storms. They have had several open burning calls. He attended the ODOT meeting on the route 20 West changes. Hydrant checking has started in the City. The department will be pursuing address grants and installation of smoke detectors in the Township. He also reported that the Training Center is getting a great deal of use.

Road Department Report:

Mr. Burhenne reported that asphalt from HEI-WIG is about \$86.00 per ton. He indicated that we need to expand our Parking area. He suggested taking a part of the lawn on the North side adding about a car length to the existing lot. Some Trees on Maple Avenue have been taken down. There are more to come down. They have been fixing the Berm on Austin Road. Sixty foot of pipe was installed for Mr. Jones. The Boom Mower is ready to go. 34 people showed up for cleanup day. He asked about cars in yards and right of way. Mr. Cerjan replied that they are sent a notice to remove the cars. It is a very long process if you have to go to court.

Zoning Department Report:

Mr. Cerjan reported that he had issued two permits, one for a sign and a Garage expansion. 3250 S. Myers Road has all kind of cars and trucks and is running an Auto repair shop. We have received numerous calls. A letter will be sent indicating his violations.

He had talked to the County Prosecutor about zoning violations. He indicated we could tow them away, however we must have an impound lot.

Fiscal Officers report.

Mr. Russell made the motion and Mr. Brown the second to approve Resolution 2018-03 (to participate in the State Salt purchase program). All Trustees voted yes.

Mr. Russell made the motion and Mr. Brown the second to approve Resolution 2018-04 (to submit a renewal Road Levy to the voters). All trustees voted yes.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 8:35 pm.
