Regular Meeting  
May 12, 2021

Chairman Mills called the meeting to order at 7:30pm.

Those present were Mr. Mills, Mr. Russell, Mr. Brown and Fiscal Officer Mrs. Huff, Zoning inspector Ron Cerjan

Mr. Russell made the motion and a second by Mr. Brown approved minutes from the April regular meeting. All Trustees voted yes. Mrs. Huff stated that the March minutes stated that Geneva Fire received the mule from Saybrook Fire and should have stated that it was purchased by Harpersfield Fire.

Mr. Russell made the motion and a second by Mr. Brown to approve bills for \$63,151.21 covered by e-payments E-59-80 and Warrants 21531-21574.

Fire Department: Mr. Russell reported that Fire Chief Dale Arkenburg will be retiring on July 10, 2021.

Zoning Report: Mr. Cerjan stated four permits were issued in April. He stated that 10 acres on Lake Rd east will have future permits issued. He received a complaint near Madison on Cunningham Road, He contacted that owner and they did get a dumpster but no further changes made. Mr. Russell stated he received notification from the county prosecutor office regarding short-term rentals and is still working on the issue.

Road Department: The pick up truck has the new bed on and the employees are happy with it. No new updates regarding the Mack Truck. Received an estimate from American Electric for \$11,057.00, for a Kohler generator in which the NOPEC Grant money will be used for payment. Mr. Russell made a motion to proceed with the purchase of the generator not to exceed \$12,000.00. A Second was made by Mr. Brown. All voted yes.

Fiscal Officer Report: Mrs. Huff stated that she received a notice from the Liquor Control Division for BBS Corner Carryout for a liquor permit. No objections made. A motion by Mr. Russell and a second by Mr. Brown to approve the request. All voted yes.

New Business: The Park Township will be donating their old laptop since they have received the new laptop from State of Ohio.

Committees: Attended the annual cemetery meeting and gave the City of Geneva and Township updates regarding the cemetery.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned at 8:03 pm, motioned by Mr. Brown and second by Mr. Russell. All trustees voted yes.
