

**Geneva Township  
Regular Meeting  
July 13, 2016**

**The meeting was called to order by Chairman Mills at 9:00am.**

**Those present were Mr. Brown, Mr. Mills, Mr. Russell, Fiscal Officer Long and Zoning Inspector Cerjan.**

**Minutes from the June meeting were approved, on a Motion by Mr. Russell and a Second by Mr. Brown.**

**Bills in the amount of \$77,359.28 covered by e-payments 68-81, and Warrants 18615-18716 were approved, on a motion by Mr. Brown and a second by Mr. Russell.**

**Road Department report. We received a complaint from a resident about the street light being too bright. The Illuminating Company has indicated that the Bulb could be changed at a cost estimated at \$5.00 per month. We will determine if it should be changed and notify the Illuminating Company. We have been crack sealing and working on Tuttle Road. We are also getting new shocks on one of the Trucks. Mr. Russell has contacted ODOT on the intersection of 534 and Maple, as to the need of a Traffic light. We have not had a response as of yet.**

**Mr. Cerjan gave the Zoning report. He issued 3 permits this Month. He has had issues with the Caranci property on Myers Road. Mr. Cerjan has forwarded a letter to Mr. Caranci giving him 30 days to clean up his property. He received a complaint at 4148 Lake Road East about burning garbage. He has been there twice and has not caught anyone home. He received a complaint about 3187 Martha drive, a vacant house. He has talked to the Health Department about it.**

**Chief Arkenburg gave the Fire Department report. He indicated that we have had 4 fatal crashes in the Township this year. He indicated he did not know why. He has been in touch with OSP to try to determine what we can do. Increased Traffic may be one of the reasons. We have had a number of small fires, which may be due to the drought. There was a fire on the fence between Eagles and WKKY. He has applied for 2 grants for Smoke Detectors, he is awaiting a reply.**

**The extension agreement for the Cell Tower is ok by the Prosecutors Office. We will proceed with SBA.**

**Mr. Russell reported that we have received our price for Road Salt at \$38.54 per ton.**

**Mr. Brown reported that 534 CIC did receive their 501 (c) 3 from IRS.**

**Mr. Mills made the motion and Mr. Brown the second that if a burning ban is necessary, Mr. Arkenburg in conjunction with Mr. Russell can make that call.**

**There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 9:45am on a motion by Mr., Russell and a second by Mr. Brown.**
