

Geneva Township  
Regular Meeting  
August 2, 2017

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Mills at 9:00am.

Those present were Mr. Brown, Mr. Mills, Mr. Russell, and Fiscal Officer Long.

Minutes from the July 2017 meeting were approved, on a Motion by Mr. Russell and a Second by Mr. Brown.

Bills in the amount of \$88,679.69 covered by e-payments E-89-97 and Warrants 19334-19363 were approved, on a motion by Mr. Russell and a second by Mr. Brown, All trustees voted yes.

Fire Department Report:

Chief Arkenburg reported work is being performed on Truck 321. A Valve had to be replaced and it should be complete soon. They have responded to calls on Austin road and Route 20 and County Line road. We have had meetings with Harpersfield and Trumbull Fire Departments in respect to Training. One of the concerns is that more rules are being created for Firefighters, which will require more training. There is a meeting coming up to address the cost of the additional training. Mutual aid will be another topic of discussion. A lot of dialog going on in the Southern County Fire Departments.

Road Department Report:

Mr. Burhenne reported chip and seal has been completed except Wheeler Creek. We need more #8 Stone to finish. We will see if we can get some additional #8 from Arms. The repairs to the 2007 Truck came in at about \$8600.00. It was repaired by Five Star out of Erie. It is running good and everything is working. Mowing is all up to date. Koski is paving 84 and 307 and then they will do Maple. The new power broom has been delivered.

Fiscal Officers report.

Mr. Long reported that a large area of land has been sold to the Museum and will reduce our Tax revenue even further.

The 534 CIC will reimburse the Township \$500.00 for the Hotel study. The Bike Path route in the Township will not be determined until the City's is final.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 9:35am.
