

Geneva Township  
Regular Meeting  
September 12, 2018

Chairman Mills called the meeting to order at 9:00am.

Those present were Mr. Brown, Mr. Russell, Mr. Mills, Fiscal Officer Long, and Mr. Cerjan.

Mr. Brown made the motion and a Second by Mr. Russell approved minutes from the August regular and August Special meetings.

Mr. Russell made the motion and a second by Mr. Brown, All trustees voted yes to, approve bills for \$ 135,743.54 covered by e-payments E-101-120 and Warrants 20006-20055.

Fire Department Report: Chief Arkenburg reported that the new Truck still need some repairs, they presently have a tank that is leaking, which is under warranty. The Training Center is being used more with classes and training. They have purchased some new frequency translators, which they were able to purchase at a reasonable price. They have remodeled the dispatch room, which is presently much nicer. He indicated we did have a fatal motorcycle accident at Austin and New London Road. They have been dealing with a great deal of open burning problems. Many cases neighbors are calling and complaining. Many of the fires include garbage. All of their annual testing is complete. They may be responding to the Carolinas to aid in the Hurricane problem.

Road Department Report: They are working on Maple Avenue and have been doing a good job of cleaning up after the pipes are installed.

Zoning Department Report: Mr. Cerjan reported he had issued two permits this past Month. He has handled a number of complaints about camping on areas, which are not designated camping areas. It appears one site is beginning to be used as campgrounds. The site is not large enough to meet our zoning criteria. He will continue to monitor the situation.

Resolution 2018-08, authorizing obtaining a Loan for the new truck, was passed on a Motion by Mr. Brown, a second by Mr. Russell and roll call was three yeses.

Fiscal Officers report. Mr. Long covered the financials and indicated we should have the 2019 Budget at our next meeting.

Mr. Russell reported that a NAD crew had left last night for the Carolinas to aid the Hurricane problem.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 9:35 am.
