Road Department Report: Mr. Young reported Salt and Grits have been ordered. They recently install a catch basin. They have been meeting with the County Engineer and ODOT at East Maple and State route 534, to discuss a drainage problem. The paving on New London and Wheeler Creek roads is complete. They are getting all Equipment ready for the winter season.

Zoning Department: Mr. Cerjan reported he had issued a permit at 5353 New London Road for an addition for a Bedroom and Bath. A permit for a Fence was issued at 998 N. Ridge West. A permit was issued at 4153 N. Myers Road for a deck with a roof. He has received several complaints which he has investigated. One at Roosevelt and Route 534 about a pool with leaves and other debris. He as well as the neighbor have contacted the Health department. The property at Addison road and Route 20 has been cleaned up.

Mr. Long reported that we had received the money from the State for our in kind work on Maple Avenue. He also indicated we received an increase in the Gas Tax as a result of the new State Tax which began on July 1, 2019. The 2020 Budget will be ready for the November meeting.

Mr. Russell indicated that Gary Welch had retired from NAD and Rob Bernardo was elevated to Assistant Administrator.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 7:45 pm.
