

Geneva Township
Regular Meeting
November 9, 2022

Chairman Mills called the meeting to order at 9:01 AM.

The pledge of Alliance was recited.

Those present were Mr. Mills, Mr. Brown, Mrs. Miller, Fiscal Officer Caya, Fire Chief Shook and Tod Young. Citizens present were Robert Russell, Barb and Jim Wood.

Mrs. Miller made the motion and a second by Mr. Brown to approve minutes from the October 12, 2022 meeting. All trustees present voted aye.

Mrs. Miller made the motion and a second by Mr. Brown. All trustees present voted yes to, approve bills for \$ 60,605.76 covered by E□payments E-182-2022 through 204-2022 and Warrants 22301 through 22333. All trustees present voted in favor of the motion.

Public Comment:

Mr. Wood commented that there are still ongoing issues with the house next door to him. There are tons of garbage, Fire Chief Shook said he can look into the issue and see if there is anything the Fire Department can do.

Fire: Chief Shook reported there were 15 incidents in October. 5 motor accidents, wire downs and open burns. There were no fire losses this past month.

Zoning Report: Mr. Cerjan reported that he issued two permits this month. He also spoke with Terri in reference to the tires on Maple Ave. This issue has been lost in the shuffle and he is not sure how long it will take. Mr. Cerjan also reported he was working with a Title Company on storm water as well as other questions on the campground.

Tim Mills reported that he wrote a letter to the County about a water issue at Austin Road trailer park. Terri Palmer has turned it over the Department of Commerce which oversees trailer parks.

There was discussion about Mr. Peet has asked for the minutes of the past couple meetings and has been asking for information from the City on the tower. There was a suggestion to let Kyle Smith know of the recent inquires.

Road Department: Tod Young reported they have been putting up the snow fence and road markers. They are also getting ready for salt delivery.

Tammy Caya reported that she received a phone call from Mr. Miller about damage his truck received from wet line stripping that was done on the roads. The Township also received a letter. Tiffany Miller also reported that the sign on Myers Road is still off.

Tim Mills reported that the Village of Geneva on the Lake wants to pave Austin Road and wants to apply for an Issue I grant. Tim talked to Tim Martin and he will be willing to do the engineering for both entities. They will give an estimate.

Fiscal Officer: Tammy Caya reported that she is completing the 2023 budget and will send it out before the next meeting for reviews. She also reported that the Township received the 2023 Anthem medical renewal. The increase was 8.9%

New Business: There was a comment made by the Election Board that the toilet in women's room was running and there was no hand soap. Tim Mills said he will have someone look at the toilet and Tammy will get some hand soap. They also requested to have a microwave.

Tiffany Miller said she talked to the electronic recycler and he suggested a Saturday in the Spring.

There was a question asked if there was any update on the trails? No update given.

Denny Brown said last year he was asked to take the quadrants and drive them and evaluate the junk problems. He did this and was very surprised how well the Townships looked and appeared to be in good shape. He made a report of his findings. There were 4 properties that were trashed, but he stated at that time Tim suggested to not do anything.

There was a discussion on the Volks properties that are in the City and Township and there was a suggestion to get with the City and work on the properties together.

There was a suggestion to get with Kyle Smith and start the zoning update discussions. Denny Brown suggested having a special meeting.
