

Geneva Township  
Regular Meeting  
November 14, 2018

Chairman Mills called the meeting to order at 7:30pm.

Those present were Mr. Brown, Mr. Russell, Mr. Mills, Fiscal Officer Long, and Mr. Cerjan.

Mr. Brown made the motion and a Second by Mr. Russell approved minutes from the October regular meeting.

Mr. Russell made the motion and a second by Mr. Brown, All trustees voted yes to, approve bills for \$ 88,388.68 covered by e-payments E-136-153 and Warrants 20098-20157.

Fire Department Report: Mr. Arkenburg reported that there were numerous calls in the Township this year. There were various reasons such as down power lines, trees, etc. He estimated over 170 calls of this type this year. He reported on a Fire on NRE. They were able to save the structure, however; he indicated that there were many code violations within the structure. It brought up the question of what we should do with rental properties in the Township. We recently had a car flip on NRE causing considerable damage to property and other vehicles. Fortunately, there were only minor injuries. There is a County chiefs meeting coming up soon to discuss a number of issues including mutual aid response. Equipment repairs are slowing down. There is an issue with First Energy and its Funding to Fire and Police departments that needs to be worked out. Chief Arkenburg introduced a new part time Fireman.

Road Department Report: Mr. Young reported that they had completed the driveway paving on West Maple Avenue. There was some question about County Line Road and response to problems. In addition, the need for better Road Closed signs was brought up. We will get prices for some new signs.

Zoning Department Report: Mr. Cerjan reported he had two or three complaints on Wheeler Creek Road. The owner has promised to clean it up. Another was a shed on wheels, which was used as a getaway. There was also a complaint at the campgrounds. He turned it over to the Health Department. They have been there several times. He also has a couple of permits to issue.

Mr. Russell made the motion and Mr. Browns the second for Resolution 2018-10 (supplemental appropriation to pay for Truck). All Trustees voted yes.

Mr. Russell made the motion and Mr. Brown the second, that we begin a recycling program on a trial basis on the Township Property. All Trustees voted yes. Mr. Long will contact the county, to get the program going.

Mr. Long reported that the Loan proceeds are in the Bank awaiting delivery of the Truck.

On a motion by Mr. Russell and a second by Mr. Brown, the Hospitalization program for 2019 was adopted, as presented by Mr. Long.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 8:30 pm
